On 7-8 September 2022, members of the EA Bureau of the Committee of the Regions in Brussels took part in a study visit to Spiš in the Prešov self-governing region. The topic of the visit was Involvement of the young generation in democratic life in Levoča, Slovakia. EA visited Spišské Podhradie and its surroundings, cultural monuments listed in the UNESCO cultural heritage, Pedagogical Secondary School in Levoča, Secondary Sports School in Poprad and School of Art Industry in Kežmark. Rafting in the Pieniny National Park and a tour of Levoča showed the beauty and possibilities of the region. The conference (8.09.2022) culminated in an **interactive discussion** in the Congress Hall of the Municipal Theater in Levoča in the presence of high school students. Organisers are glad that representatives from so many countries understand the need to work with students, because they are our future. They are the way to build a stronger EU. Recommendations EA Chairman Karl Vanlouwe emphasized the need to realize the European identity and create strong bonds, especially in times of wars and crises, when these bonds provide us with security and stability. EA Vice President Dariusz Strugala highlighted the importance of education and praised the activity and tangible results of the youth. It is therefore absolutely necessary to support and develop this potential, because school is a place where personality is formed.
