State of play JTF February 2024

Upward trend in implementation

- Project selection rate doubled since December 23 to 6.1%
- Half of the JTF allocation is in calls

Project cycle kicks in: JTF implementation is expected to gain significant pace in the coming months.

Project pipelines through targeted TA of Just Transition Platform and JASPERS.



Bottlenecks of implementation

- MS with weak or instable institutions have problems with starting the implementation
- Limited planning and implementation capacities of beneficiaries lead to delays
- Complex state aid cases continue to be a daunting challenge for MS
- Limited capacties in Managing Authorities to adapt calls to rapidly changing circumstances



Project examples

- Slovakia: Geothermal district heating plant, Košice
- Greece: <u>Bioeconomy Hub 360°</u>, Megalopoli
- Netherlands: Project <u>Greenwise Campus</u>, Groningen
- Sweden: <u>H2-Labs</u>, Norbotten



Lessons

- Focus on the most vulnerable territories
- Advancement of transition
- Integrated approach
- Strengthened partnership
- Strategic approach based on strong analysis
- Targeted territorial scope and conditionality of transition
- Visibility
- Just transition mechanism



Conclusions

- Transition needs a cohesion focus
- JTF provides a proven strategic framework for involving local stakeholders
- Method allows focusing on the most vulnerable territories/sectors
- Integrated and targeted approach
- Transitions need to come with strong and targeted technicial assistance
