This consultation is being conducted by the European Committee of the Region's (CoR) network of regional hubs (R e g H u b) .

The questionnaire aims to put together the views of the hubs on the impact of the EU's Common Agricultural Policy (CAP) implementation on the territorial development of rural areas and changes that would be needed in order to overcome difficulties encountered by them.

Who should respond to the questionnaire?

The questionnaire should be answered and sent back to the RegHub secretariat by the RegHub contact points. They can consult regional authorities responsible for implementing CAP instruments, farmers' organisations, agribusiness sector/SMEs and any other stakeholder at local/regional level involved in the development of rural areas and in the implementation of the CAP.

IMPORTANT: *Whenever answers are based on consultations of stakeholders, this should be indicated in the 'synthesis' boxes under each question and each of the consulted stakeholders should always be identified.*

Background and context

One of the EU's main objectives is to strengthen its economic, social and territorial cohesion. The Treaty on the functioning of the European Union (TFEU) requires the EU to promote harmonious development and to seek to reduce disparities. The TFEU also calls for ensuring a fair standard of living for the agricultural community, in particular by increasing the individual earnings of people engaged in agriculture.

Rural and intermediate areas account for 90% of the EU's territory, are home to 60% of its population, generate 49% of its gross value added and play host to 56% of its jobs.

The CAP is intended to contribute to balanced territorial development through a series of measures to reduce the gap between agricultural incomes and other sectors and by supporting economic development, employment, growth, poverty reduction and social inclusion in rural areas - all financed as part of the EU Rural Development Policy. Direct payments to farmers are also intended to help maintain a diversified agricultural sector and balanced territorial development.

The Commission has launched an evaluation of the CAP impact on territorial development of rural areas, which is part of a series of evaluations of the performance of this policy against its general objectives[1]. More concretely, the Commission will assess the extent to which CAP instruments and measures have contributed to balanced territorial development in rural areas, focusing on socio-economic aspects such as social inclusion. The evaluation will feed into the 2021 report to the European Parliament and the Council on how the CAP is performing, and serve further policy development in this area. The corresponding background study should be available by the end of the year while the publication of the Evaluation Staff Working Document is planned in the third quarter of 2020.

The CoR would like to contribute to this evaluation and to extend the consultation to other structural funds because the CoR notes that European support for rural areas is falling sharply and that the way the European Structural and Investment Funds (ESIF) are being used is exacerbating the disparities between urban and rural areas. There is, therefore, an urgent need to identify challenges and make specific commitments to the development of rural areas in Europe.

Results and follow-up of this consultation

The results of this consultation will be compiled in a RegHub implementation report. The CoR will endeavour to maximise the impact of the implementation report of this consultation on the European Commission's ongoing review of the CAP evaluation.

Previous RegHub consultations have highlighted RegHub's strong potential to gather unique user-experience data from relevant local and regional stakeholders on the implementation of EU policies. This matches the European Commission's goal to achieve evidence-based policymaking through targeted and inclusive stakeholder consultations, which has already led to the European Commission taking the results of the RegHub consultations on board for their policy reviews.
