### There are more than a million politicians elected at regional/local level in the EU!



A <u>survey conducted in October 2021</u> by Ipsos on behalf of the CoR confirms that 88% of local politicians think it is important to increase their influence at EU level




think stronger involvement of sub-national government will make EU democracy work better


### Follow-up from the October Bureau:

#### Applications by country










**Q9** Have you engaged with the Committee of the Regions before? (% by country)
