

1) Have your say on Europe - Mobile app (Google Android / Apple iOS)




2) Map of local events



Between March 2016 and October 2017, 90 local events in 20 European countries were organised by the European Committee of the Regions (CoR) in partnership with its members and local and regional partners.

Overall, the Reflecting on Europe initiative will generate over 140 local events/citizens' debates across Europe reaching out to around 20 000 citizens and involving more than 150 CoR members.



Between March 2016 and October 2017, 90 local events were organised by the European Committee of the Regions (CoR) in partnership with its members and local and regional partners in 20 European countries involving 8,500 citizens.


