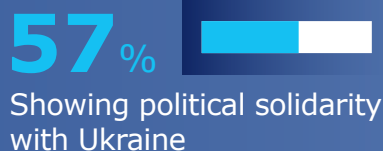
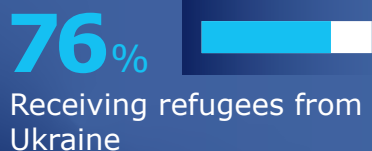

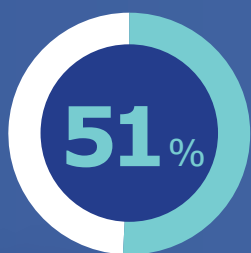

Actions taken by local or regional authorities in response to the war against Ukraine

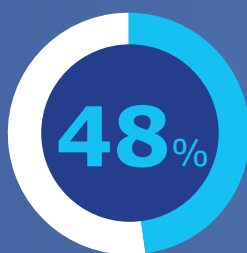

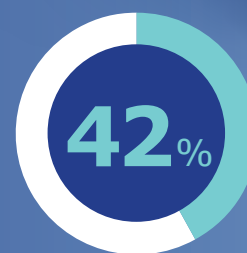

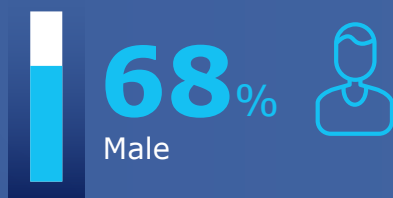
