Survey questionnaire for the report on "Speeding up the clean energy transition at local and regional level: the impact of the Fit for 55 package"

1. Short Description

This online survey questionnaire aims to serve as the basis for the report on "Speeding up the clean energy transition at local and regional level: the impact of the Fit for 55 package", commissioned by the European Committee of the Regions (CoR) Directorate for Legislative Work I – Unit B2 (ENVE commission), and executed by Milieu Consulting srl. Data may also be collected through interviews.

The objectives of the study are to: identify the relevant changes introduced by the Fit for 55 package, focusing particularly on those relevant to LRAs and specifying the scale of the measures/procedures/targets (local/regional) and the timeline for transposing these new obligations; create an overview of existing and newly established financial and non-financial support mechanisms for the implementation of the above-mentioned policies (energy efficiency, renewable energy and energy performance of buildings); and outline a set of policy recommendations for different policy-makers on how to ensure that local and regional authorities can effectively and smoothly implement new energy legislation under the Fit for 55 package.

2. Who is responsible for the processing of personal data?
